#### **Investment Strategy**

The Intermediate-Term Municipal Fund, (the "Fund") seeks to preserve capital and maintain a high degree of liquidity while providing current income that is exempt from federal income taxes. Under normal circumstances, the Fund will invest at least 80% of its net assets in municipal securities that pay interest that is exempt from federal income taxes. The principal issuers of these securities are state and local governments and their agencies located in any of the fifty states, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico and other U.S. territories and possessions. The Fund will strive to maintain an average dollar-weighted portfolio maturity of three to ten years.

#### **Investment Philosophy and Process**

The Fund uses a multi-manager approach to portfolio construction that seeks to generate excess returns (i.e., returns in excess of benchmark) and at the same time provide diversification by avoiding overconcentration in a single investment style, sector or market trend. Our analysis seeks to identify each manager's competitive advantage and characteristics of that advantage that can be monitored on an ongoing basis. Asset allocation to a given manager is based on the manager's skill set, the current macro economic environment, and the risks inherent in each manager's strategy.





### **Glossary and Important Information**

**30-day SEC Yield:** An annualized yield based on the most recent 30 day period and includes any principal value changes to TIPS securities to reflect changes in the government's official inflation rate. Changes in the inflation rate can cause the fund's yield to vary substantially from one month to the next. An extraordinarily high SEC yield may be attributable to a rise in the inflation rate, which might not be repeated. The unsubsidized 30-day SEC Yield is an approximation illustrating the effect to the 30-day SEC Yield if fees were not waived during that period.

**Effective Duration:** Duration is a measure of a security's price sensitivity to changes in interest rates. Specifically, duration measures the potential change in value of a bond that would result from a 1% change in interest rates. The shorter the duration of a bond, the less its price will potentially change as interest rates go up or down; conversely, the longer the duration of a bond, the more its price will potentially change.

Weighted Average Life: The average number of years for which each dollar of unpaid principal on a loan or mortgage remains outstanding.
